INTRODUCTION TO THE 2019 MONMOUTH RAFT RACE

The 2019 Monmouth raft race is raising funds for St David's Hospice Care. The event starts at 12 noon on 1st September and finishes 6.5 miles downriver at Whitebrook.

All crew members need to be familiar with the **Regulations** for the event. In particular the ones covering **raft design**, the need for each crew member to obtain and wear a **life jacket**, and the **total ban on use of water cannons**.

A web page link to the **Regulations** is sent to each entrant shortly after we receive their entry.

It is a sponsored event, and it is a condition of entry that each crew raises a minimum of £100 in sponsorship in support of St David's Hospice Care.

A web page link to the **Sponsorship Form** is sent to each entrant shortly after we receive their entry. All crew members are asked to print a copy of the form and to collect sponsorship, from friends and colleagues

When all the sponsorship money is collected, it should be sent (with the forms), to the address on the form. We need the completed sponsorship forms in order to collect **Gift Aid** on eligible donations.

Friends and colleagues can donate **Online** through **Justgiving**, if they wish. Each crew member can set up an individual **Justgiving** web page. Full instructions about how to set up a page can be found at www.monmouthrafttrace.com
